PURPOSE: Sergeant's Flea & Tick Powder with Permethrin provides quick killing action and long lasting control of fleas and ticks on dogs.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not apply product directly in or on eyes, mouth, or genitalia of animals. Do not use on (or cause exposure to) puppies less than 12 weeks. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, pregnant, medicated or nursing animals. Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide product for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately.

Apply powder liberally over the entire body. Work dust into hair and around feet, pads and between the toes by rubbing against the lay of the hair until dust penetrates to skin.
