**PURPOSE:** SERGEANT'S Flea & Tick Spray is formulated as an effective water based residual pet repellent for use on dog's fur, effectively controlling fleas & ticks and giving your pet 23 days of protection. [The product may be sprayed from any angle, downwind. It is also quieter than normal aerosol sprays for use on your pet.]\*\*

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. From a distance of approximately 8-12 inches and stroke against the lay of the coat, moving the dispenser rapidly, flush the pet's skin (include the legs and underbody but avoid the face).

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Store in original container, inaccessible to children and pets. To dispose of empty container, place several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not reuse.
