- Correct the spelling of "scent."
- Under the Precautionary Statements, delete the word "intended" in the eight sentence so it reads, "Collar is for external use only."
- Delete the following claims:
  - "Fast-Acting"
  - "Quick Kill"
  - "Kills The Ticks That Carry Lyme Disease [Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever] [Ehrlichiosis]"
  - "Thus, collar controls fleas and ticks, including ticks that may carry [Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever] [Lyme disease] [Ehrlichiosis]."
  - "Wetting collar will not impair collar's effectiveness."
  - "It is not necessary to remove collar if pets go swimming or are out in the rain."
- Revise the following:
  - "Kills Fleas and Ticks for 93) (4) (5) months [990) (120) (150) days]" to read "Controls fleas for up top three months (90 days) on cats and four months on dogs. Aids in the control of ticks on dogs for up to four months."
  - "This collar kills fleas and ticks for (3) (4) (5) months" to read "This collar kills fleas and ticks for (3) (4) (5) months [990) (120) (150) days]" to read "Controls fleas for up top three months (90 days) on cats and four months on dogs. Aids in the control of ticks on dogs for up to four months."
  - "Collar is a double layer sustained-release system working to provide fast acting [quick kill] and long-lasting head-to-tail protection" to read "Collar is a double layer sustained-release system."
