Subject: Amendment reconsider label changes required by Re-registration letter dated 9/23/08 concerning efficacy claims by re-examining previously submitted data Sergeant's Sendran Flea & Tick Collar EPA Registration No. 2517-78 Your Submissions Dated January 13, 2011

The efficacy review attached dated 6/8/11 supersedes the review previously emailed to you dated 5/31/11. It seems as though the data supporting a 10% collar continue to be allowed to be bridged to your 9% collar and the new memo revises any statements that didn't allow or review data on 10% collars. Please refer to this memo for further details and clarifications.

Most of the conditions outlined in the reregistration letter dated 9/23/08 are still applicable. The claims that will now be allowable to be added onto your label include:

- Controls fleas on cats for up to 5 months.
- Kills [adult] fleas which may cause flea bite anemia
- Kills [adult] fleas which may cause flea allergy dermatitis
- Kills [adult] fleas which may transmit tapeworms

The labeling referred to above submitted in connection with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended is acceptable provided you make the following changes as required in the reregistration letter (unless otherwise noted):

Delete the following claims:

- 1. "Fast-Acting"
- 2. "Quick Kill"
- 3. "Kills the Ticks that Carry Lyme Disease [Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever][Ehrlichiosis]"

- 4. "Thus, collar controls fleas and tick, including ticks that may carry [Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever][Ehrlichiosis]"
- 5. "Wetting collar will not impair collar's effectiveness"
- 6. "It is not necessary to remove collar if pets go swimming or are out in the rain"

Revise the following claims:

- 1. Kills Fleas and Ticks for (3)(4)(5) months [(90)(120)(150) days]" to read "controls" fleas for up to five months (140 days) on cats and four months on dogs. Aids in the control of ticks on dogs for up to four months" *
- 2. "This collar kills fleas and ticks for (3)(4)(5) months" to read "controls fleas for up to 5 months on cats and four months on dogs. Aids in control of ticks on dogs for up to 4 months."
- 3. "collar is a double layer sustained-release system working to provide fast acting [quick kill] and long-lasting head-to-tail protection" to read "Collar is a double layer sustained-release system."
- 4. "Under normal conditions, replace collar ever (3)(4)(5) months. Under conditions of severe infestation and where rapid kill is desired, collar may be replaced more often" to read "Replace every 4 months. Under conditions of severe infestation, collar may be replaced more often." *

Other required changes:

Revise the claim that says "[For [Dogs], [Large Dogs], [Small Dogs & [Puppies], [Cats]" to read "[For [Dogs], [Large Dogs], [Small Dogs & [Puppies over 12 weeks of age], [Cats over 12 weeks of age]" unless Companion Animal Safety data can be provided for animals younger than this age restriction.
