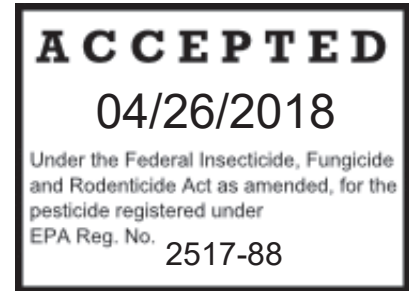

Sergeant's PreTect Squeeze-On is an effective easy to use product. This product prevents eggs from fleas on treated cats from developing into biting adults for three months. As with all flea control products, Sergeant's PreTect Squeeze-On should be used as a part of a program aimed at reducing flea populations. For existing flea infestations, a premise treatment including an adulticide and larvacide should be used prior to treating your pet with Sergeant's PreTect Squeeze-On. Consult your veterinarian or entomologist or retailer for program recommendations.

DO NOT ALLOW CHILDREN TO APPLY PRODUCT. TO PREVENT HARM TO YOU AND YOUR CAT, READ ENTIRE LABEL BEFORE EACH USE. FOLLOW ALL DIRECTIONS AND PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS CAREFULLY. Do not use on animals other than cats. Do not allow your cat to ingest this product. Do not use on kittens under 12 weeks of age. Do not apply to cats weighing less than 6 lbs. Use entire contents of tube on each cat. [Do not split one tube between two cats.] Do not double-dose cats. Separate the treated cat from all other cats and dogs for 24 hours after treatment has been applied. Do not get this product in your cat's eyes or mouth. Repeat applications may be made if necessary, but do not apply more often than once every 3 weeks. Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

SIDE EFFECTS: Monitor your cat after application. [Some cats may experience temporary startle effects when any product is applied.] Cats may experience some temporary irritation at the site of product application such as redness, scratching or other signs of discomfort. If signs of sensitivity occur, bathe your cat with a mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If these or other side effects occur, consult your veterinarian or call 1-800-781-4738. If your cat has an unusual reaction to the initial application, consult a veterinarian before repeating application. The most common signs of incidental ingestion are excessive salivation and foaming at the mouth. Holding tube with notched end pointing up and away from face and body, cut off narrow end at notches. Invert tube over cat or kitten and use open end to part cat's or kitten's hair. Apply contents of one tube of Sergeant's PreTect Squeeze-On solution as a spot or stripe, starting high on the back of the cat's or kitten's neck behind its head. Wrap tube and put in trash. Repeat application in 3 months.

BLISTER CARD WITH TRI-LAYER TUBES: Remove product tube(s) from package. Fold along perforation between tubes and tear off one tube. [Return unused tubes to package.] Holding tube with notched end pointing up and away from face and body, snap off narrow end at notches. Invert tube over cat or kitten and use open end to part cat's or kitten's hair. Squeeze tube firmly to apply contents of one tube of Sergeant's PreTect Squeeze-On solution as a spot or stripe, starting high on the back of the cat's or kitten's neck behind its head. Wrap tube and put in trash. Repeat Application in 3 months.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
