- 1. First and Second Labeling Claims: Delete these newly added labeling claims as they might indicate false or misleading information regarding this product's performance and/or effectiveness.
- 2. Third Labeling Claim: Replace the word "Control" with the word "Kills."

3. 7. Immediately preceding the sentence starting with "Dust bedding, kennel...," insert the following new sentence as follows:

"In addition, follow application with a complete brushing of the cat's hair to remove dead insects." 4

3. Submit two (2) copies of the revised final printed label for the record, incorporating the above changes, before the product is released for shipment.

Sergeant's should note that a notice of availability of EPA's reregistration eligibility decision (RED) document for products containing pyrethrins was published in the *Federal Register* on July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143, Pages 42387-42389). Further, EPA's RED for products containing piperonyl butoxide was published in the *Federal Register* on July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143, Pages 42385-42386). As a result, additional data and/or labeling changes may be required for products containing pyrethrins and piperonyl butoxide.

If the above conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
