Dear Mr. Hoskins:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable.

Within forty-five (45) days from the date of this letter, Sergeant's should submit a label amendment revising the "Warranty & Disclaimer" section in accordance with the guidance document entitled, "Guidance on Warranty Statements" and dated October 17, 2006. This update can be found at the following hyperlink: <http://www.epa.gov/pesticides/regulating/labels/warranty.pdf>.

Sergeant's should also note that a notice of availability of EPA's reregistration eligibility decision (RED) document for products containing pyrethrins was published in the *Federal Register* on July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143, Pages 42387-42389). Further, EPA's RED for products containing piperonyl butoxide was published in the *Federal Register* on July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143, Pages 42385-42386). As a result, additional data and/or labeling changes may be required for products containing pyrethrins and piperonyl butoxide.

If the above conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

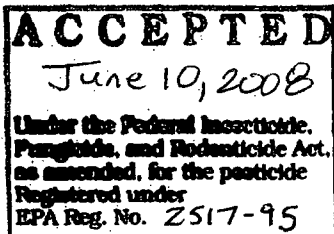

Dust bedding, kennel and sleeping areas regularly. Repeat as necessary but do not treat more than once a week. Pets may be treated indoors or outdoors. In order to help reduce the occurrence of fleas and ticks, this product is best if used year round.
