The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following provision(s):

Storage and Disposal Statement section comment(s), page 3 of 3 (BACK PANEL):

 In the 1<sup>st</sup> sentence of the line labeled as "Pesticide Storage:," replace the word "only" with the words "this product."

Warranty & Disclaimer Statement section comment(s), page 3 of 3 (BACK PANEL):

- 2. Replace the 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> sentences with: "The directions for use of this product are believed to be adequate and must be followed carefully. However, it is impossible to eliminate all risks inherently associated with the use of this product. Unintended consequences may result because of such factors as weather conditions, presence or absence of other materials, or the manner of use or application, all of which are beyond the control of Sergeant's."
- 3. Replace the 9<sup>th</sup> sentence with: "To the extent consistent with applicable law, Sergeant's, the manufacturer, or the Seller disclaims any liability whatsoever for special, incidental, or consequential damages resulting from the use of this product."

Sergeant's should also note that a notice of availability of EPA's reregistration eligibility decision (RED) document for products containing pyrethrins was published in the *Federal Register* on July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143, Pages 42387-42389). Further, EPA's RED for products containing piperonyl butoxide was published in the *Federal Register* on July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143, Pages 42385-42386). As a result, additional data and/or labeling changes may be required for products containing pyrethrins and piperonyl butoxide.

A copy of your label stamped "Accepted with Comments" is enclosed for your records. Please submit two (2) copies of the final printed labeling, incorporating the above changes, before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes accepting of these conditions.
