- a. Change the product registration number to "EPA Reg. No. 2517-96"
- b. Make the following label revisions:

Labeling Claims section comment(s), page 1 of 3:

- 1. First Labeling Claim: Delete the newly added labeling claims regarding this product being herbal and/or botanically-based. These claims are misleading since they give the false impression that this product is derived solely from plants (botanicals) when, in fact, the product's active ingredients are a combination of botanicals and other chemicals. ¹
- 2. Fourth Labeling Claim: Replace the word "Control" with the word "Kills."

Ingredient Statement section comment(s), page 1 of 3:

3. Revise to read as follows:

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:

Pyrethrins	0.06%
Piperonyl Butoxide Technical*.....	0.60%

OTHER INGREDIENTS** 99.34%

*Equivalent to 0.48% (butylcarbityl (6-propylpiperonyl) ether and up to 0.12% related compounds.

**Contains petroleum distillates.

4. 6. In the 1st sentence following the title block referenced in item #5 above, replace the words "[cats] [and] [dogs]" with "[dogs] [cats] or [dogs or cats]." ²


- 3. Submit two (2) copies of the revised final printed label for the record, incorporating the above changes, before the product is released for shipment.

Sergeant’s should note that a notice of availability of EPA’s reregistration eligibility decision (RED) document for products containing pyrethrins was published in the *Federal Register* on July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143, Pages 42387-42389). Further, EPA’s RED for products containing piperonyl butoxide was published in the *Federal Register* on July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143, Pages 42385-42386). As a result, additional data and/or labeling changes may be required for products containing pyrethrins and piperonyl butoxide.

If the above conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
