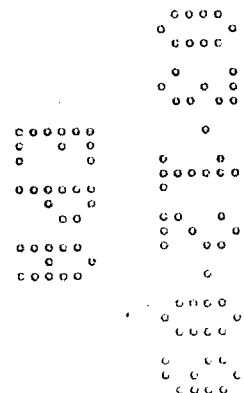

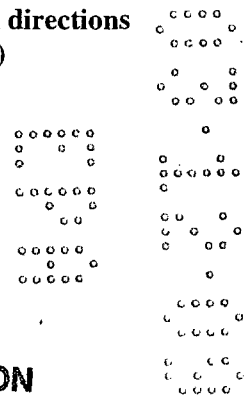

[This 16 oz. bottle should be sufficient for [three applications to an average 30-35 lbs. of dog] [or] [20 applications to a 10 lb. cat]]. **OR** [This 8 oz. bottle should be sufficient for [two applications to an average 20-25 lbs. of dog] [or] [10 applications to a 10 lb. cat]]. When applied at the label dose rate, the [dog] [or] [cat] should not be retreated more frequently than once every 14 days. Lighter applications will reduce period of effectiveness, may result in earlier reinfection and may require more frequent retreatment. 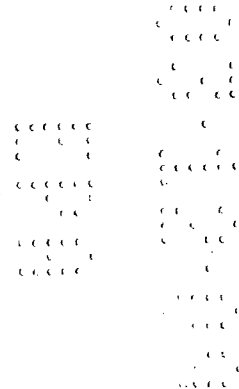
