The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

#### **Conditions of acceptance**

- 1. This registration is now time-limited and expires two years from the date of this letter.
- 2. Please consider limiting the formulations of this product to one basic confidential statement of formula. The Agency may require this in the future and no additional alternate formulations or minor formulation amendments will be approved for this product in the future.
- 3. You must submit quarterly enhanced incident reports and quarterly sales information in doses sold for this product beginning January 1, 2014. Please flag any Confidential Business Information as such. Enhanced incident reporting should be submitted to the Product Manager. Please flag any Confidential Business Information as such. Enhanced incident reporting should be submitted to the Product Manager. Quarterly sales information should be submitted to the attention of Kaitlin Keller, Pesticide Reevaluation Division, Mail Code 7508P.






