The above-referenced registrations contain conditions as stated in the initial registration notices, dated 11/04/2010, 11/04/2010, and 01/28/2011, respectively, for these products to expire in two years. The terms of these registrations have been previously updated to extend the expiration dates to 9/11/2021 for EPA Reg. No. 2517-134 and 9/11/2019 for both EPA Reg. No. 2517-136 and EPA Reg. No. 2517-137. But for limited Agency resources, your requests would have been granted prior to the expiration dates. Additionally, your company is required to adhere to the spot-on label mitigation, and to submit quarterly enhanced incident reports and quarterly sales information for the above-referenced registrations.

The Agency has found Sergeant's Pet Care Products, LLC to be in compliance with the terms and conditions for the subject products. The Agency is therefore granting the requests to extend the two-year time-limited registration restrictions. As such, the following change is being made to the terms and conditions of the products listed above.

- **The two-year time-limited registration restriction has been extended. The new expiration date for the registrations listed above is now September 11, 2025.**
