FOR EXTERNAL USE ON CATS ONLY. Do not use on kittens under 12 weeks of age. Use entire contents of tube [vial] on each cat. [Do not split tubes between cats.] [Do not use multiple tubes on one cat.] Do not treat your cat with more than one pesticide product at a time. Over dosing your cat can result in serious illness and even death. **Best if used year round**. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, medicated cats. Consult a veterinarian before using on cats with known organ dysfunction. Separate the treated cat from all other cats and dogs for 24 hours after treatment has been applied. Cats and dogs that actively groom or engage in close physical contact with treated cat may be at risk of serious harmful effects. How to apply: While holding the cat with one hand, use the other hand to apply the solution. Invert the tube *[vial]* and use the narrow end to part the cat's hair. 
