

How to Apply

Weigh dog or puppy 8 weeks and older, to determine appropriate application rate using the following chart:

Application to be made using commercially available 5 mL (syringe must have 0.2 mL graduations), luer tip disposable syringe without needle. Use of non-sterile syringe is acceptable since applications are topical. Use syringe [(not included)] to measure and withdraw the appropriate amount of solution by inserting the syringe into the top of the bottle. Refer to table above for application rates. Part the dog's hair and apply entire amount directly to the skin of the dog, as directed below. Do not apply more often than once every [4 weeks] [30 days]. When finished using product, replace the cap.

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FREQUENCY OF APPLICATION
