

DIRECTIONS

GENERAL DISINFECTANT: After thoroughly cleansing all surfaces to be disinfected, spray or rinse with solution of two ounces of Hygieia per gallon of water.

TO CONTROL THE SPREAD OF ATHLETE'S FOOT FUNGI: The floors of all locker rooms, shower rooms, swimming pool decks, and any other places where people walk with bare feet should be sprayed or rinsed thoroughly with a solution of 8 ounces of Hygieia per gallon of water. Apply with sprinkling can or spray gun after floors have been cleaned.

STAINS: Hygieia removes stains, among them being the stubborn ones made by grease, fruit, grass, medicine, blood, coffee, tea, and ink. Mercurochrome, iodine, Argyrol, mildew and scorch yield to its action. Use 1 ounce to a quart of water, followed by a thorough rinse. For tile, porcelain, sink and drainboard, use Hygieia full strength with wet cloth. Rinse well.

DIRECTIONS

DISHES, GLASSWARE: After washing, immerse glasses, cups, silverware, dishes, etc., in a solution of Hygieia containing $\frac{1}{2}$ ounce per gallon of water. (200 ppm) Rinse the inside of refrigerators and their drain pipes, after cleaning, with a solution of 1 ounce of Hygieia per gallon of water to help kill the germs that may cause spoilage of food and decay.

FOR BLEACH IN THE LAUNDRY: Use 1 pint of Hygieia for every 100 pounds of clothes in the first rinse after suds, followed by a rinse of clear water. Do not use Hygieia on colored goods, silks, or wool. Hygieia is safe on white and colorfast cotton, linen, nylon, rayon, acetate, Dacron, Orlon, Acrilan, Kodel, Arnel and blends of these fibers.

CAUTION

Hygieia is concentrated and must be diluted. Harmful if swallowed. Prolonged contact may cause skin and eye irritation. If Hygieia is splashed in eyes, flood with water. If Hygieia is swallowed, feed milk. **CALL PHYSICIAN.** Do not use with other household chemicals such as ammonia or bowl cleaners.
