DIRECTIONS

GENERAL DISINFECTING: Remove all filth and dirt from the premises and use a solution of 1½ ounces to each gallon of water.

FLOORS: When mopping or scrubbing, use 1½ ounces of Beta-Cide to each gallon of water in the bucket.

TOILET ROOMS, WATER CLOSETS, URINALS: Wash the closet and urinal bowls regularly with a solution of 1/3 cupful of Beta-Cide in each gallon of water, leaving the solution in the bowl as long as possible. Scrub the floor and seat frequently with this solution.

NOTE: Always put Higley Beta-Cide Disinfectant in pail first and then add the water. It forms a creamy, milk-white emulsion which does not separate on standing.
