



Dead-Lite Residual Spray is a residual action insecticide effective in the control of harmful and obnoxious crawling insects such as cockroaches, ants, household spiders, wasps, mosquitos, box elder bugs, crickets, centipedes, waterbugs, silver fish and carpet beetles. This non-staining spray leaves the kitchen or premises clean and, unlike powders, does not leave any messiness behind.

DIRECTIONS

Apply only as spot treatments in the home or premises limiting the treatment to those surfaces where the pests have been seen or where they are suspected of hiding. Such treatments would normally be limited to a maximum of 20% of the floor and lower wall surfaces including shelving and cabinets.

IN GENERAL use a coarse, wet spray, or in the absence of a sprayer, use a paint brush, paint roller or similar means to treat surfaces and other areas where the insects rest, run or hide. REPEAT TREATMENT AS OFTEN AS NECESSARY.

ROACHES AND WATERBUGS: Spray or paint infested cracks and other hiding places and adjacent exposed surfaces where roaches and waterbugs will crawl when they come out of hiding.

SILVERFISH: Spray or paint baseboards, areas behind shelving, book cases and storage areas.

ANTS: Spray or paint ant trails and areas around door sills and window frames where pests may enter. Also around water pipes, heat ducts, electrical outlets and baseboards where ants may come into rooms from wall spaces and partitions.

CARPET BEETLES: Spray or paint infested areas of carpets, localized areas of floors and baseboards and into cracks and under carpets where these pests may be found. Localized treatments of areas on floors, baseboards and shelves of closets may also be indicated.

WASPS AND MOSQUITOES: These pests are not considered crawling insects but thorough and repeated spraying of surfaces such as doors, around windows and areas frequented by these insects indoors.

BOX ELDER BUGS: Spray or paint around doorsills, window frames or wherever these pests may enter the house. Also treat areas where these insects crawl or congregate on porches or sides of houses.

CRICKETS: Spray or paint baseboards, floors of closets and storage places and other hiding places.

SPIDERS AND CENTIPEDES: Spray or paint infested baseboards and corners and of pipes, storage localities and other infested areas in basements.

IMPORTANT: IN ALL APPLICATIONS OF DEAD-LITE RESIDUAL SPRAY FOR CRAWLING INSECTS - REPEAT TREATMENT AS OFTEN AS NECESSARY

CAUTION: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Harmful if swallowed. Repeated or prolonged contact with skin can cause toxic symptoms. In case of contact with skin, wash with soap and water. Avoid breathing spray mist. Dead-Lite contains petroleum naphtha and should be used with care on certain types of composition flooring such as rubber, asphalt tile, etc.
