

When ALGO is used as directed, it will kill and prevent development of *Chlorella pyrenoidosa* (green), *Phormidium inundatum* (black algae), *Phormidium rotz* (Square D algae), *Lyngbya versicolor* (blue-green) and other swimming pool algae.

ALGO is compatible with most commonly used swimming pool chemicals, but should not be mixed with soap or other cleaners, or premixed with other water-treating chemicals. ALGO works best when added by itself directly to pool water. ALGO's use dilution is non-corrosive to inanimate surfaces.

DANGER

Keep Out of Reach of Children. Causes severe eye and skin irritation. Irritation in eyes, skin or on clothing, if rubbed or data if swallowed. Wear goggles, gloves, and rubber gloves when using. Avoid contamination of food.

FIRST AID

In case of contact, flush eyes with water or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, flush with water and wash as carefully as possible. If swallowed, drink milk or water, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Always consult a physician.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Probable mucous membrane irritation from the use of gastric lavage. May cause circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Initial Dose: 1 gallon ALGO to 50,000 gallons of water.

Maintenance Dose: 1 quart ALGO to 50,000 gallons of water.

Initial dose is used when filling pool at beginning of swimming season. If pool has visible algae growth, treat with initial dose. Vacuum pool after 24 hours to remove algae debris. If visible algae are still present or re-appear, repeat this treatment procedure as necessary. When pool is free of visible algae, use the recommended maintenance dose.

Maintenance dose should be added at 3-5 day intervals. If high temperatures prevail or pool has unusually heavy use, add maintenance dose more frequently.

If make-up water is added at the rate of more than 10% per week of pool capacity, add 1 quart of ALGO for each 10,000 gallons of fresh make-up water added per week.

When swimming season is over, add 1 gallon of ALGO to 50,000 gallons of water in treating water left in pool. This dose helps provide a measure of control of algae growth during the winter months. This treatment will also help the servicing of the pool before it is returned to use the following season.
