

Add ¹8 cup of bleach per each 2 gallons of water. Boiling is unnatessary. Mix well. Wash in usual way. As a bleach add ¹8 cup or ¹ oz per 2 gallons water or one cup bleach per each washing machine load (16 gallon machine). Rinse in several waters before drying. In automatics bleach should be added to suds water before clothing is placed in machine. If added while clothing is in suds, dilute with 1 quart of water before adding.

or other stains, add ¼ cup of bleach to quart of water. Mix well and allow to soak until stains disappear. Rinse thoroughly.

To clean sinks, bathtubs, tile, linoleum, porcelain, etc., spread solution with cloth. Let stand 2 minutes. Rinse well. DO NOT use on silverware. TOILET BOWLS: Use ½ cup, pour in bleach and swab with brush. Let stand for 10 minutes and then flush DO NOT use with other toilet bowl cleanser, ammonia or household chemical.

First remove starch or dressing from white cotton and linen garments by soaking in cold water. Make a solution of two tablespoons of Empire Bleach to one quart of cold water — mix well. Any remaining brown spots usually vanish with vinegar or lemon juice.
