Dear Mr. Snider:

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, is acceptable, provided that you:

Submit one copy of your final printed labeling incorporating the following corrections before you release the product for shipment.

1. Add the following ventilation statement for indoor use as specified in the 1988 Malathion Reregistration Standard.

"Use only with adequate ventilation. After using this product indoors, ventilate thoroughly before occupying enclosed spaces. Do not allow contact with treated surface until sprays have dried."

2. On the center panel, correct the typo, "I" in the sentence, "I can be hazardous..." to read: "It can be hazardous..."

3. Revise the statements under "Environmental Hazards" to read as follows:

"This product is toxic to fish, aquatic invertebrates and aquatic life stages of amphibians. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters."

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If this condition is not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of this condition.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

1. PROHIBITIONS

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

2. PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your state pesticide or environmental control agency or the hazardous waste representative at the nearest EPA regional office for guidance.

3. CONTAINER DISPOSAL

Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

4. GENERAL INFORMATION

Consult federal, state and local disposal authorities for approved procedures other than those given above. Approved procedures vary considerably for different types of generators.

AS A CLEAN-UP FOR GRAIN FACILITIES:

DO NOT APPLY THIS PRODUCT ON OR DIRECTLY OVER GRAIN. Empty grain storage structures may be treated prior to filling with corn, barley, oats, rye and wheat (including triticale) only. First clean up the storage bin's floor, elevator, elevator boot, bin deck, galley, tunnel, handling equipment, ship hold, barge, grain trailer and all other grain facilities to be sprayed. Best results are obtained when the emulsion is used on clean surfaces. Mix 1 gallon of this concentrate with 20 gallons of water and spray the surfaces until they are wet. Allow the surface to dry before grain is allowed to contact it.
