This is in reference to your label amendment submitted with your application of September 14, 1992 requesting deletion of unsupported malathion uses; and your application of January 27, 1995 transmitting an amended basic Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) and updated labeling with the unsupported uses deleted.

The amended CSF described above is acceptable and has been included in our file for the product.

Please verify whether this amended CSF is to replace all previously submitted basic CSFs.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided that you:

Submit one copy of your final printed labeling incorporating the following corrections before you release the product for shipment.

1. Correct the statements appearing under the heading, "Environmental Hazards" to read as follows.

"This product is toxic to fish, aquatic invertebrates, and aquatic life stages of amphibians. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters."

2. The ingredient statement designation, "Inert Ingredients" must appear on the label in the same type size and prominence as

the designation, "Active Ingredient".

If this condition is not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of this condition.
