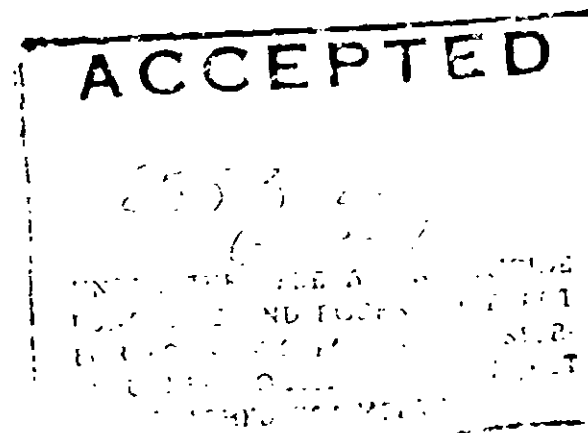

DIRECTIONS:

ZEE-TOX BRAND COPPER WOOD TREATMENT should be applied over the entire surface. Every crevice, joint, crack, and nail end must be treated. It should have a flowing action on all wood prior to use in construction in order to provide protection against termites, decay, and fungi.

Lumber intended to be in contact with the soil should be dipped for a minimum of three minutes or if treated by the brush or spray method, receive two or more flowing coats of this product.

For protection against termites, treat wood prior to use in construction. Fence posts, poles, foundation timbers, and heavy wooden members should be free of bark, dry and well-seasoned and immersed in this product for a period of 12 to 48 hours to be an effective wood preserver.

CLOTH: Only enough **ZEE-TOX COPPER WOOD TREATMENT** should be applied to dampen both sides since an excess of the solution may cause sticky areas. Insufficient solution may leave areas susceptible to fungal attack.

ROPE: Sponge on solution with a cloth or a short dipping period may be used. As rope is withdrawn from bath it should be wiped well to remove any excess solution.

CAUTION:

Do not reuse empty container. Destroy it by perforating or crushing.

Bury or discard in a safe place away from water supplies.

Do not reuse empty drum. Return to drum manufacturer or destroy by perforating or crushing and burying in a safe place away from water supplies.
