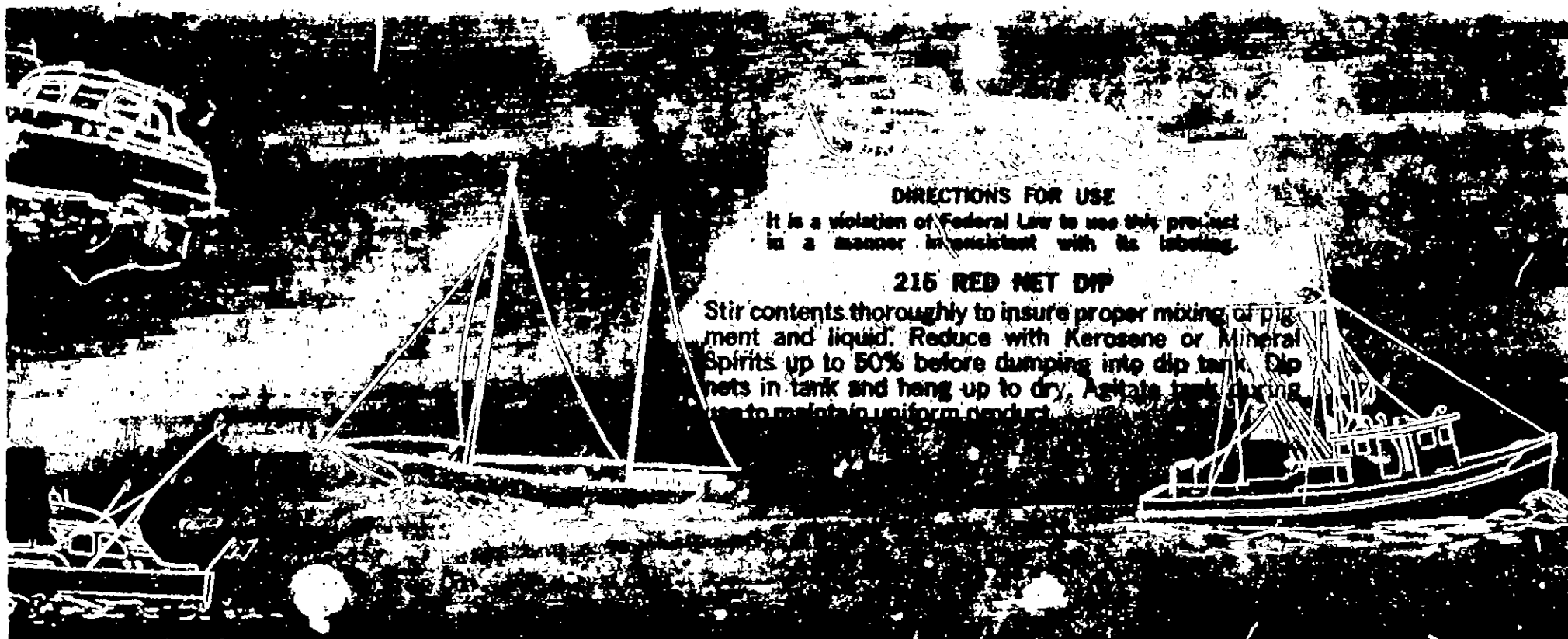

#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

#### **215 RED NET DIP**

Stir contents thoroughly to insure proper mixing of pigment and liquid. Reduce with Kerosene or Mineral Spirits up to 50% before dumping into dip tank. Dip nets in tank and hang up to dry. Agitate tank during use to maintain uniform product.

#### **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**PESTICIDE:** Any of this material, or rinse solvent that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to Federal or approved state procedures under Subtitle C of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act.
