Place the collar around your dog's neck. Tighten by pulling the two ribbons through the ring.

 Tie the two ribbons securely to the collar. Make three knots and cut off surplus ribbon.

If your dog has a large neck tie the ribbons to the ring.

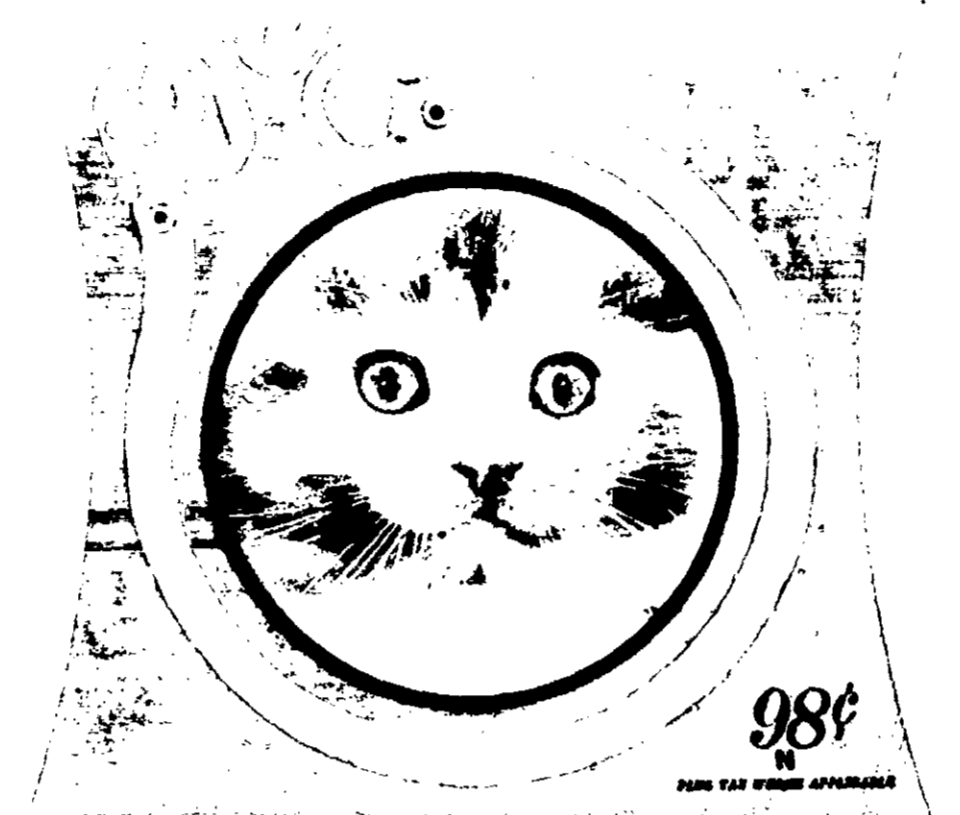

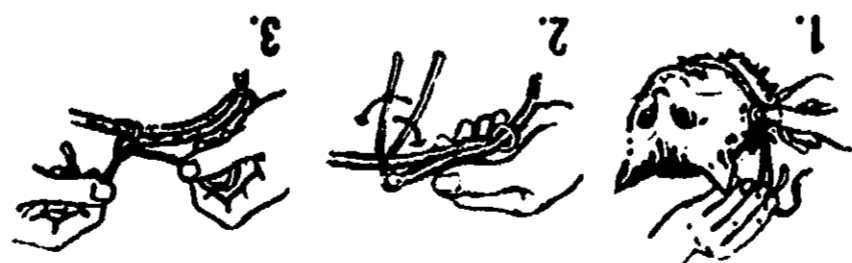
