

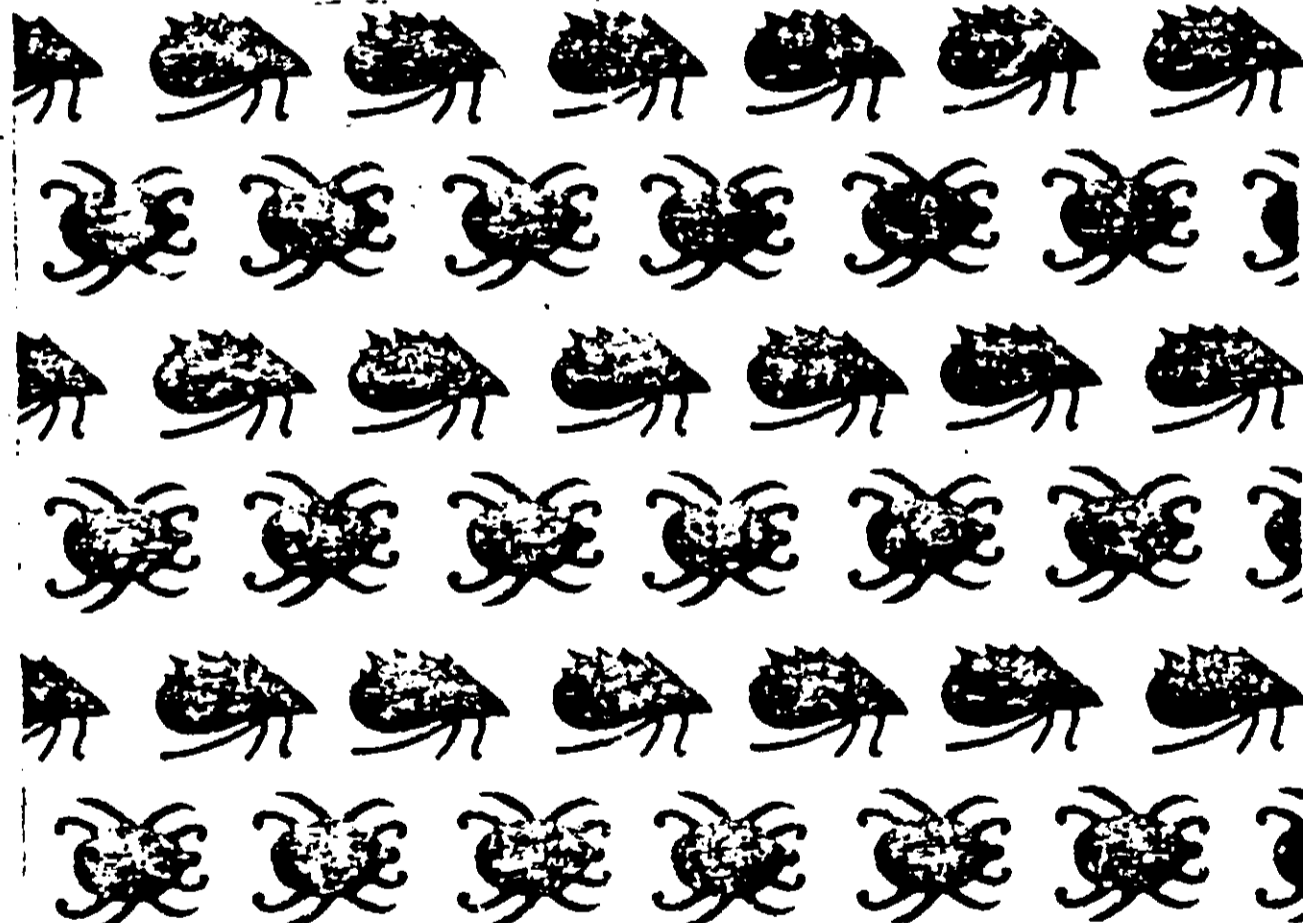

**DIRECTIONS:**

1. Shake well. Remove overcap.
2. Hold can upright about 10 to 12 inches from pet. Point nozzle toward pet and press button. Do not hold tip of finger in front of nozzle. Move can to get even coverage of coat (until tips of hair are moist).
3. Apply lightly and rub into animal's coat. Ruffle hair for spray to reach skin. Spray 4 to 6 seconds to a five pound cat, vary according to weight of cat.
4. Dry with towel.
5. Comb and brush coat.
6. Repeat once a week if necessary. Use on bedding and surrounding areas as needed.
7. Kills fleas in 5 to 10 minutes. Ticks are tough—spray directly.

**CAUTION:** Contents under pressure. Do not puncture or incinerate can. Don't use near heat or store at temperatures above 120° F. Do not use near birds, fish or foodstuffs. Do not spray in eyes or face of cat. Do not use on kittens under 6 weeks old.
