Dear Ms. Bieler,

Your application for amended registration, dated August 1, 1996, and the revised labeling submitted with your application have been reviewed. Your application indicated that you intend to combine the indoor uses on the label for EPA Reg. No. 2596-27 with the outdoor uses on the current label for 2596-28 onto one product label under EPA Reg. No. 2596-28, and that you would like to change the product name for 2596-28 to "Hartz Indoor and Outdoor No."

Your application and amended labeling for "Hartz Indoor and Outdoor No" submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, are acceptable provided that you modify the proposed labeling as indicated below.

- 1. Under "PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS," change the second and third sentences to read:

"Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling."

- 2. Also under "PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS," delete the entire block of text that appears after (but NOT including) the sentence "Do not apply to food crops." The block to be deleted begins with the sentence "Do not allow persons or pets to enter the treated area until sprays have dried," and ends with the sentence "As soon as possible, wash thoroughly and change into clean clothing." This text is similar to Worker Protection Standard (WPS) requirements for personal protective equipment (PPE) and restricted entry intervals (REIs); however, based on the directions for use on the proposed

proposed text pertaining to PPE and REI are not required and inclusion of such text on your labeling would be confusing to users of the product.

3. Since your product is labeled for use outdoors, your labeling must include an **"ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS"** statement. Below the **"STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT"** and above the statement of **"PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARD,"** insert the following statement:

**"ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:**

Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwater or rinsate.

4. The headings **"STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT,"** **"ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS,"** and **"PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARD,"** should all be centered on the page so that it is clear that these are headings to the statements below them.
5. Under **"DIRECTIONS FOR USE,"** **"OUTDOOR USE"** add the word "lightly" to the first sentence in between the words "evergreen" and "spray" and delete the words "lightly every day or every other day with this product" from the end of the sentence. Also, change the last sentence in this paragraph to read "Re-apply every day or every other day until undesirable habits of your pet or stray animals are changed."
6. Under **"STORAGE AND DISPOSAL,"** modify the **"STORAGE"** instructions to read "Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame and inaccessible to heat or open flame."

A stamped copy of the draft labeling is enclosed for your records. Please submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, your registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions. ### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**GENERAL:** For both indoor and outdoor situations, proper training by you is the best way to control your pet. This repellent product should be used in conjunction with training.

**INDOORS:** To break your pet of undesirable habits (such as sleeping on the furniture, rugs and other forbidden areas in your home), spray the article of furniture, rugs, etc., lightly with this product so that the area or object is slightly moistened. Before spraying extensive areas of rugs, fabrics or plastics, test the effect of this product by first treating a small, less obvious area. This product may stain or soften some fabrics or plastics. An alternate method to avoid possible damage is to spray a piece of cloth lightly and place it on the object or area in your home to be protected. Repeat daily, or as necessary, until undesirable habit is broken.

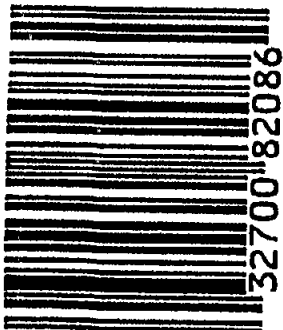
**OUTDOOR USE:** To prevent your pet or stray animals from soiling flower beds, areas of lawn, trees, shrubbery or evergreens, spray the edges of flower beds, trunks of trees, the bases of shrubbery and evergreens, patches of lawn, etc. lightly every day or every other day with this product. Stray animals are frequently attracted to areas where urine or feces have been deposited. First, remove any droppings, then spray the spot with this masking odor. Re-apply as often as necessary until undesirable habits of your pet or stray animals are changed.

**NOTE:** This product is not likely to break the established urination patterns of dogs, unless used as a training aid. Do not apply directly to foliage or shrubs or to ornamental, soft-bodied plants.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.

**DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
