The amended label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. This approval does not affect any conditions that were previously imposed on this registration. You continue to be subject to existing conditions on your registration and any deadlines connected with them.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling. The next label printing of this product must use this labeling unless subsequent changes have been approved. You must submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 18 months from the date of this letter. After 18 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance.

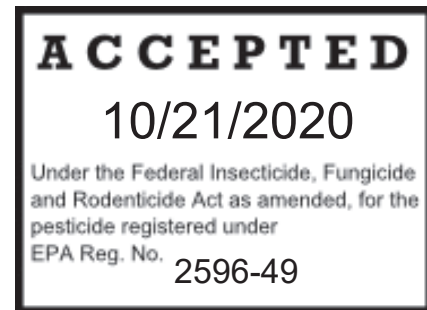

Cholinergic symptoms may include: salivation, miosis, incoordination, muscle fasciculation and/or weakness, vomiting, and diarrhea. Atropine is antidotal. 2-PAM may be effective as an adjunct to atropine. Call 1-800-275-1414 [1-800-234-2269] [1-800-781-4738] or your local poison control center for further information.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Restrictions: Do not use on kittens under 12 weeks of age weighing less than 5 lbs. Do not unroll collar until ready to use. Do not use this product on animals simultaneously or within 30 days before or after treatment with or exposure to cholinesterase inhibiting drugs, pesticides or chemicals. Do not replace this collar earlier than 3 months.

This collar is intended for use only as an insecticide.

Precautions: Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, medicated, pregnant and nursing animals. Sensitivity may occur after using ANY pesticide product for pets. Some animals may become irritated by any collar if it is applied too tightly. If irritation continues, remove collar from the animal. If signs of sensitivity occur, remove the collar and bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue consult a veterinarian.

Application Instructions:

Remove collar from package, unroll and stretch to activate insecticide generator.

Place the collar around the cat's neck, adjust for proper fit and buckle in place. The collar must be worn loosely to allow for growth of the cat and to permit collar to move about neck. A proper fitted collar is one that fastened will snugly slide over the cat's head. Leave 2 to 3 inches on the collar for extra adjustment and cut off and dispose of the extra length.

For continuous flea protection, replace the collar every 3 [three] months. Ticks may be an occasional problem for cats. The collar will kill ticks including the deer tick, which may carry Lyme disease, for 3 [three] months and continue to aid in their control an additional 30 days. The cat should be examined from time to time and collar replaced when mature tick or flea populations begin to appear. However, do not replace this collar earlier than 3 months.

Wetting will not impair the collar's effectiveness or pet's protection. If the cat is out and in the rain it is not necessary to remove the collar. The collar may be worn with a regular collar.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in a cool, dry (preferably locked) place that is inaccessible to children and animals.

Pesticide Disposal: If Empty: Non-refillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Offer for recycling, if available.

If partially filled, call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
