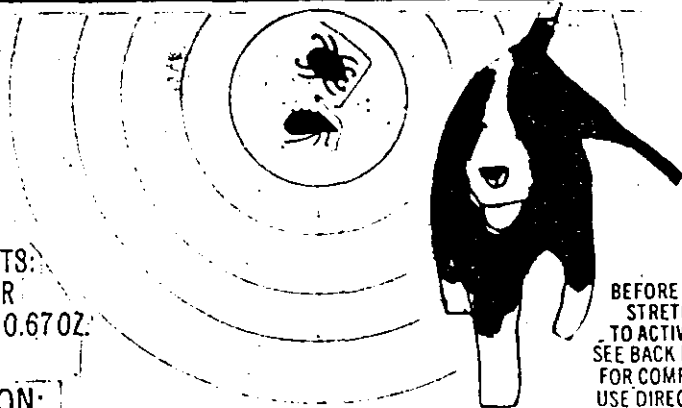

UNCONDITIONAL MONEY-BACK GUARANTEE by HARTZ

DIRECTIONS: REMOVE COLLAR FROM PACKAGE, UNROLL, AND STRETCH TO ACTIVATE INSECTICIDE GENERATOR.

Do not unroll collar until ready to use. Place the Hartz "2 in 1" collar around the dog's neck, adjust for proper fit, and buckle in place. The collar must be worn loosely to allow for growth of the dog and to permit the collar to move about the neck. Generally, a properly fitted collar is one that when fastened will snugly slide over the dog's head. Leave 2 or 3 inches on the collar for extra adjustment and cut off and dispose of the extra length.

For continuous protection under normal conditions, replace the collar every 3 months. Under conditions where dogs are exposed to severe tick and flea infestations it may be necessary to replace the collar every 2 months. The dog should be examined from time to time and the collar replaced when mature tick or flea populations begin to appear. The collar will continue to function even when wet. If the dog goes swimming or is out in the rain, it is not necessary to remove the collar.

The Hartz "2 in 1" collar may be worn with a regular collar.
CAUTION: Do not allow children to play with this collar. This collar is intended for use only as an insecticide generator.

Some animals may become irritated by any collar if it is applied too tightly. If this occurs loosen the collar. If irritation continues, remove the collar from the animal and consult your veterinarian.
