REMOVE COLLAR FROM PACKAGE, UNROLL AND STRETCH TO ACTIVATE, AS THE COLLAR BEGINS TO WORK A FINE WHITE POWDER WILL APPEAR ON THE SURFACE

It is not advisable to use this collar or similar pesticides on puppies less than 6 weeks of age. Do not unroll collar until ready to use. Place the Longlife 90 Day Brand™ collar around the dog's neck, adjust for proper fit, and buckle in place. The collar must be worn loosely to allow for growth of the dog and to permit the collar to move about the neck. Generally, a properly fitted collar is one that when fastened will snugly slide over the dog's head. Leave 2 or 3 inches on the collar for extra adjustment and cut off and dispose of the extra length. Some animals may become irritated by any collar if it is applied too tightly. If this occurs loosen the collar. If irritation continues, remove the collar from the animal. This collar is intended for use only as an insecticide generator.

For continuous flea protection under normal conditions, replace the collar every 3 months. Under conditions where dogs are exposed to severe flea infestations it may be necessary to replace the collar every 2 months. Collar will kill ticks, including Rocky Mountain Wood Tick, carrier of Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever, and the Deer Tick, which may carry Lyme Disease, for 60 days and continue to aid in their control an additional 30 days. The dog should be examined from time to time and the collar replaced when mature tick or flea populations begin to appear. Wetting will not impair the collar's effectiveness or the pet's protection. If the dog goes swimming or is out in the rain it is not necessary to remove the collar. The Longlife 90 Day Brand collar may be worn with a regular collar.

DISPOSAL—Do not use empty pouch. Dispose in trash collection.
