This product repels dogs and cats for up to 24 hours when applied daily. Keeps pets away from trees, shrubs, garbage cans/bags, and other "forbidden areas".

NOTE: This product is not likely to break the established urination patterns of dogs unless it is used as a training aid.

Pretreatment Directions: Stray animals are frequently attracted to areas where pets have soiled with feces or urine. To discourage repeat visits, remove any droppings and clean with water.

Application Directions: Do not apply directly to foliage of shrubs or to ornamental, soft-bodied plants. Do not apply to food or feed crops. Lightly spray surrounding soil or apply to a piece of cloth and affix near area to be protected every day.

Retreatment Directions: Repeat daily, or as necessary, until undesirable habit is broken.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place away from heat or open flame and inaccessible to children and pets.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
