On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by other.

Based on your response to the Reregistration Eligibility Documents, EPA has reregistered the product listed above. Enclosed is a copy of your label stamped "Accepted with Comments". This action is taken under The authority of section 4 (g) (2) (c) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended. Registration under this section does not eliminate the need for control reassessment of pesticides. EPA may require submission of data at anytime to maintain the registration of your product.

With regards to labeling, we are evaluating the last accepted label on file (dated April 27, 1999) since this label supercedes labeling submitted for reregistration. You must make the labeling changes listed below.

- 1) Based upon the acute toxicity profile for this product:
 - a) Your product is required to have "Precautionary Statements", with the subheading of "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals". You may not include these statements in your "Directions for Use". Your "Precautionary Statements" should appear as the following:

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

- b) Your product is required to have a "First Aid" statement, which should be located near your "Precautionary Statements". It should state the following:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting or if available by administering syrup of ipecac. If person is unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

- c) Your product is also required to have a "Note to Physicians and Veterinarians". This should be located directly below your First Aid Statement and should contain the following information:

- Technical information on symptomatology;
- Use of supportive treatments to maintain life functions;
- Medicine that will counteract the specific physiological effects of the pesticide;
- Company telephone number to specific medical personnel who can provide specialized medical advice.
- Information for veterinarians.

- 2) Please delete the statement "For continuous flea and tick protection under normal conditions replace the collar every 5 months. Under conditions where dogs are exposed to severe flea or tick infestations it may be necessary to replace the collar more frequently". The second sentence of this statement is ambiguous and does not provide the consumer with the minimum acceptable amount of time between applications. Please replace the above with this statement: "For continuous flea and tick protection under normal conditions replace the collar every 5 months. Under conditions where dogs are exposed to severe flea or tick infestations it may be necessary to replace the collar more frequently, however do not replace the collar more frequently than every ____ months " (the minimum duration between collar changes should be based on your efficacy and domestic animal safety data).

- 3) We note that you have referred to your product both as “Hartz 2 in 1 Plus Long Lasting Collar for Dogs” and “Hartz 2 in 1 Flea and Tick Collar for Dogs”. Please identify which is the primary name. If you have not already done so, please alert the Agency to an alternate brand name. You may do this through the Notification process.

- 4) Please submit two (2) copies of your final printed label before you release the product for shipment. Please refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

Do not use on puppies under 6 weeks of age. Do not unroll collar until ready to use. Place the Hartz® 2 in 1 Flea & Tick Collar around the dog's neck, adjust to proper fit, and buckle in place. The collar must be worn loosely to allow for growth of the dog and to permit the collar to move about the neck. Generally, a properly fitted collar is one that when fastened will snugly slide over the dog's head. Leave 2 or 3 inches on the collar for extra adjustment and cut off and dispose of the extra length. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged or medicated animals. If used on pregnant or nursing dogs, do not replace collar until the puppies are at least 6 weeks old. Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide product for pets. Some animals may become irritated by any collar if it is applied too tightly. If this occurs, loosen the collar. If irritation continues, remove the collar from the animal. If signs of sensitivity occur, remove the collar and bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately. Do not use this product on animals simultaneously or within 30 days before or after treatment with or exposure to chemotherapy inhibiting drugs, pesticides, or chemicals. However, flea & tick collars may be immediately replaced. This collar is intended for use only as an insecticide generator. The collar will begin to kill fleas and ticks immediately. Its full protection against harder to kill ticks will be built up within a few days after being placed on the pet. For continuous flea and tick protection under normal conditions, replace the collar every five months. Under conditions where dogs are exposed to severe flea or tick infestations it may be necessary to replace the collar more frequently. Wetting will not impair the collar's effectiveness or the pet's protection. If the dog goes swimming or is out in the rain it is not necessary to remove the collar. The Hartz® 2 in 1 collar may be worn with a regular collar.

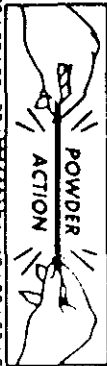
