### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

#### REMOVE COLLAR FROM PACKAGE, UNROLL AND STRETCH TO ACTIVATE. REMOVE PAPER COVER FROM REFLECTING STRIP.

The "2 in 1 Plus" Reflecting Flea and Tick Collar provides an added dimension of night-time safety for the pet and his owner. The collar will reflect when light shines directly on the reflecting strip. To demonstrate this effect, sit in your parked car with the headlights on and have someone walk the cat into the headlight beam. The reflecting strip on collar will shine bright white from car or truck headlights, making the pet visible to the driver for up to 450 feet.

For continuous flea protection under normal conditions, replace the collar every 5 months. Under conditions where cats are exposed to severe flea infestations it may be necessary to replace the collar every 4 months. Ticks, which may be an occasional problem for cats, are harder to kill. The collar's full protection against ticks will be built up within a few days after being placed on the animal. The "2 in 1 PLUS" Reflecting collar will kill ticks for 5 months under normal conditions. The cat should be examined from time to time and the collar replaced when mature tick or flea populations begin to appear. Wetting will not impair the collar's effectiveness or pet's protection. If the cat is out in the rain it is not necessary to remove the collar. The Hartz "2 in 1 PLUS" Reflecting collar may be worn with a regular collar.

Do not unroll collar until ready to use. Then unroll, stretch and remove paper cover from reflecting strip. Place the Hartz 2 in 1 Plus Reflecting collar around the cat's neck, adjust for proper fit and buckle in place. Be sure that the reflecting strip is on the outside of the collar. The collar must be worn loosely to allow for growth of the cat and to permit the collar to move about the neck. Generally, a properly fitted collar is one that when fastened will snugly slide over the cat's head. Leave 2 or 3 inches on the collar for extra adjustment and cut off and dispose of the extra length. Some animals may become irritated by any collar if it is applied too tightly. If this occurs loosen the collar. If irritation continues, remove the collar from the animal. This collar is intended for use only as an insecticide generator.

DISPOSAL - Do not use empty pouch. Dispose in trash collection.
