

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling

REMOVE COLLAR FROM PACKAGE, UNROLL AND STRETCH TO ACTIVATE INSECTICIDE GENERATOR

Do not unroll collar until ready to use. Place the Hartz "2 in 1+m" collar around the cat's neck, adjust for proper fil, and buckle in place. The collar must be worn loosely to allow for growth of the cat and to permit the collar to move about the neck, Generally, a properly fitted collar is one that when fastaned will snugly slide over the cat's head. Leave 2 or 3 inches on the collar for extra adjustment and out off and dispose of the extra length. Some animals may become irritated by any collar if it is applied too tightly, if this occurs loosen the collar, if irritation continues. remove the coller from the animal. This coller is intended for use only as an insecticide generator.

For continuous flea protection under normal conditions, replace the collar every 5 months. Under conditions where cats are exposed to severe flea infestations it may be necessary to replace the collar every 4 months. Ticks, which may be an occasional problem for cats, are harder to kill. The collar's full protection against ticks will be built up within a few days after being placed on the animal. The "2 in 1+x" collar will kill ticks for 5 months under normal conditions. The cat should be examined. from time to time and the collar replaced when mature tick or flas populations begin to appear. Wetting will not impair the collar's effectiveness or pet's protection. If the cat is out in the rain it is not necessary to remove the collar. The Hartz "2 in 1-" collar may be worn with a regular collar.

DISPOSAL-Do not use empty pouch. Dispose in trash collection.
