

## REMOVE COLLAR FROM PACKAGE, UNROLL AND STRETCH TO ACTIVATE INSECTICIDE GENERATOR

Do not unroll collar until ready to use. Place the Hartz "2 in 1 plus "" collar around the cat's neck, adjust for proper fit, and buckle in place. The collar must be worn loosely to allow for growth of the cat and to permit the collar to move about the neck. Generally, a properly litted collar is one that when fastened will snugly slide over the cat's head Leave 2 or 3 inches on the collar for extra adjustment and cut off and dispose of the extra length. Some animals may become irritated by any collar if it is applied too tightly. If this occurs loosen the collar, if irritation continues, remove the collar from the animal This collar is intended for use only as an insecticide generalor.

For continuous flea protection under normal conditions; replace the collar every 5 months. Under conditions where cats are exposed to severe flea infestations it may be necessary to replace the collar every 4 months. Ticks, which may be an occasional problem for cats, are harder to kill. The collar's full protection against ticks will be built up within a few days after being placed on the animal. The "2 in 1 plus"" collar will kill licks for 5 months under normal conditions. The cat should be examined from time to time and the collar replaced when mature tick or flea populations begin to appear. Wetting will not impair the collar's effectiveness or pel's protection. If the cat is out in the rain it is not necessary to remove the collar. The Harlz "2 in 1 plus" collar may be worn with regular collar.

DISPOSAL - Do not use empty pouch. Dispose in trash collection.
