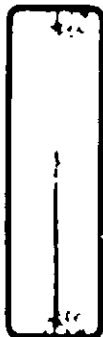

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Remove collar from package. Unroll and stretch to activate insecticide generator. Place collar around cat's neck. Adjust for proper fit and buckle in place. The collar must be worn loosely to allow for growth of the cat and to permit the collar to move about the neck. Generally, a properly fitted collar is one that when fastened will snugly slide over the cat's head. Leave 2 or 3 inches on the collar for extra adjustment and cut off and dispose of the extra length. Some animals may become irritated by any collar if it is applied too tightly. If this occurs, loosen the collar. If irritation continues, remove the collar from the animal. This collar is intended for use only as an insecticide generator.

### REMOVE COLLAR FROM PACKAGE, UNROLL AND STRETCH TO ACTIVATE INSECTICIDE GENERATOR

For continuous flea protection under normal conditions, replace the collar every **5 months**. Under conditions where cats are exposed to severe flea infestation it may be necessary to replace the collar every 4 months. Ticks, which may be an occasional problem for cats, are harder to kill. The collar's full protection against ticks will be built up within a few days after being placed on the animal. The 2 in 1 collar will kill ticks, including the Lyme Disease carrier of Lyme Disease, for **5 months** under normal conditions. The collar should be examined from time to time and the collar replaced when flea populations begin to appear. Wetting will not impair the collar's effectiveness or pet's protection. If the cat is out in the rain, do not remove the collar. The Hartz 2 in 1 collar may be worn with a dog collar. **DISPOSAL:** Do not use empty pouch. Dispose in trash. Do not burn.

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is not acceptable for the following reasons :

1. The polymer for the pigment and the pigment yellow are new inert ingredients in pesticide products and requires Agency's review prior to approval. Refer to the attachment for the kind of data required. If you pursue clearance of these inert components, your supplier should make application to:

2. We note that these products contain the toxic inert ingredient **dioctyl adipate**. EPA published an FR Notice (54 FR 48314-Nov. 22, 1989) which added dioctyl adipate to List I inert of concern. Products containing this inert of concern were required to bare the statement, "**This product contains the toxic inert ingredient dioctyl adipate.**" by May 22, 1990 (later extended to August 22, 1990). Products released for shipment after May 22, 1991 must have the amended label in place. Our review of the subject files does not indicate amended application nor revised labeling in accordance with the FR Notice. This

should receive your immediate attention.
