It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling

REMOVE COLLAR FROM PACKAGE, UNROLL AND STRETCH TO ACTIVATE. BEGINS TO WORK A FINE WHITE POWDER WILL APPEAR

It is not advisable to use this collar or similar pesticides on kittens. Do not unroll collar until ready to use. Place the Hartz 2 in 1 collar around the cat's neck and buckle in place. The active ingredient on the surface of the collar onto your pet's coat providing continuous protection from fleas and ticks. The collar must be worn loosely to allow for growth. The collar should permit the collar to move about the neck. A properly fitted collar fastened will snugly slide over the cat's head. Leave 2 or 3 inches of extra length for adjustment and cut off and dispose of the extra length. Some irritation by any collar if it is applied too tightly. If this occurs and irritation continues, remove the collar from the animal. This collar acts only as an insecticide generator.

For continuous flea protection under normal conditions replace collar every four months. Under conditions where cats are exposed to severe flea infestations, it may be necessary to replace the collar every two months. Ticks, which are harder to kill, are a problem to cats. The collar's full protection appears within a few days after being placed on the animal. The 2 in 1 collar including the Deer Tick, which may carry Lyme Disease, for five months. The cat should be examined from time to time and the collar replaced if mature tick or flea populations begin to appear. Wetting will reduce effectiveness or pet's protection. If the cat is out in the rain it is not the collar. The Hartz 2 in 1 collar may be worn with a regular collar. **DISPOSAL**— Do not use empty pouch. Dispose in trash collection.
