

REPELS FLIES, GNATS AND MOSQUITOES
KILLS FLEAS, LICE AND TICKS

DIRECTIONS:

1. Hold bottle upright 6 inches from pet. Direct spray toward pet and spray entire coat, pressing dispenser with quick, short strokes. Move bottle to get even coverage of coat (until tips of hair are moist).
2. Apply lightly and rub into animal's coat. For long haired dogs, ruffle hair to reach skin.
3. After 10 minutes dry dog with towel.
4. Comb and brush coat.
5. Repeat once a week for fresh, glossy coat. Use on bedding and other areas as needed.
6. Kills fleas in 5 to 10 minutes. Ticks are tough—spray directly.

CAUTION: Do not use near birds, fish or foodstuffs. Do not spray in eyes or face of dog. Do not use on puppies under 8 weeks old. Do not reuse container. Destroy when empty.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

- a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 2596-94."
- b. "Keep Out of Reach of Children" should precede the signal word.
- c. The heading "Directions" should appear directly following the heading, "It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling."
- d. The precautionary statement paragraph should be headed by HAZAROUS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS and followed by the signal word CAUTION. The following precautionary wording must be added to the label:

BEST DOCUMENT AVAILABLE

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, or clothing. In case of contact immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

- e. The Storage and Disposal statement should read: "Do not empty container. Wrap container and place in trash can."
- f. The Confidential Statement of Formula should be revised to show the percent weight of MGK 5192 (all ingredients in the concentrate). Also in the ingredient statement, Technical Piperonyl Butoxide should be changed to Piperonyl Butoxide, Technical, and the chemical identity of Ameroxol OL-10 should be supplied.
3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
