Your Application Dated June 26, 1990

The proposed amendment to the registration of the product cited above under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, removing the active ingredient, MGK R-11, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

1. Submit the product-specific product chemistry and data matrix for this amended formulation.
2. Submit the flashpoint of this product with the propellant or add the phrase "Extremely Flammable," to the physical and chemical cautions.
3. Update the storage and disposal statement by adding the statement "Do not puncture or incinerate."
4. Provide the chemical identity of the following ingredients. Include a Material Safety Data Sheet and the Chemical Abstracts Service (CAS) Number for each.
  - a. Phase B5
  - b. Antifoam FD-62

In the case of the fragrance, each chemical component of the fragrance must be identified by CAS number and percentage in the mixture.

5. Submit a 1-year storage stability study. The formulated product must be analyzed for its active ingredients at time zero and during a year of storage. The storage must be under warehouse conditions of temperature and humidity using containers similar to those that will be used in the trade. This data must be submitted within 15 months of the date of this letter.

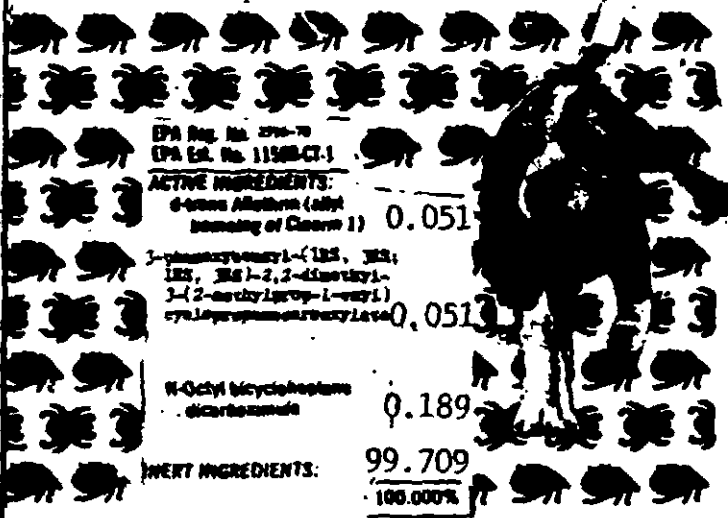

2. Hold can upright about 10 to 12 inches from pet. Point nozzle toward pet and press button. Do not hold tip of finger in front of nozzle. Move can to get even coverage of coat (until tips of hair are moist).
3. Apply lightly and rub into animal's coat. For long haired dogs, ruffle hair to reach skin.
4. After 10 minutes dry dog with towel.
5. Comb and brush coat.
6. Repeat once a week for fresh, glossy coat. Use on bedding and other areas as needed.
7. Ticks are tough—spray directly.

Disposal: Do not re-use empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
