On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

Based on your response to the Reregistration eligibility Documents, EPA has reregistered the product listed above. This action is taken under the authority of section 4 (g)(2)(c) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended. Registration under this section does not eliminate the need for control reassessment of pesticides. EPA may require submission of data at anytime to maintain the registration of your product. with regards to labeling, you must make the labeling changes listed below. This is with regards to your most recent stamped label 12 April 1999.

- 1). The Ingredients Statement must include the chemical name "(Z)-2-chloro-1-(2, 4, 5-trichlorophenyl) vinyl dimethyl phosphate."
- 2). Your product must contain the header "First Aid" and the following statements of "First Aid":

FIRST AID

"IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger or if available by administering syrup of ipecac. If the person is unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting."

"IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. If symptoms persist, get medical attention."

"IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists."

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- 3) Your product is required to have a "Note to Physicians and Veterinarians." This should be located directly below your "First Aid" Statement and should contain the following information:
 - Technical Information on symptomatology;
 - Use of supportive treatments to maintain life functions;
 - Medicine that will counteract the specific physiological effects of the pesticide;
 - Company telephone number to specific medical personnel who can provide specialized medical advice;
 - Information for veterinarians.

- 4) Based on the Acute Toxicology profile of this product and PR Notice 96-6, the statement of "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" must read as follows:

"Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reaction in some individuals. Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Not for use on kittens less than 12 weeks of age. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged or medicated animals. Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide product on pets. If signs of sensitivity occur, bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately."


- 5) The header "Directions" currently on the label must be revised to read "Directions for Use".



- 6) Per the product chemistry review, the label should include a storage statement for the product which instructs the product users where the product should be stored to maintain activity of the product and to prevent hazards or accidents from inadequate storage.

- 7) The Pesticide & Container Disposal statements must be modified to read as follows:

"Do not re-use empty container. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash".

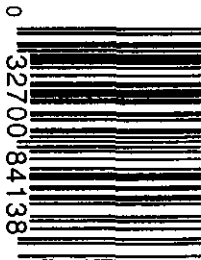

Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide product for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur, bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately. Do not use this product on animals simultaneously or within 30 days before or after treatment with or exposure to cholinesterase inhibiting drugs, pesticides, or chemicals. However, flea & tick collars may be immediately replaced.

DIRECTIONS: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To kill fleas, ticks and lice, and to reduce itching and scratching due to insect bites, dust entire cat beginning at head and working back. Make sure that the powder gets down to the skin. Take care to treat feet and legs. Dust cat's bedding and living quarters. Repeat at weekly intervals if necessary.

Disposal: Do not re-use empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection. Do not contaminate water by disposal of waste.

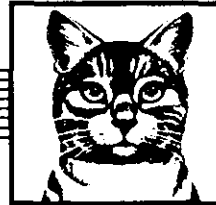
