minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then
continue rinsing eye. Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for treatment
advice.

Have the product container or label with you when calling a Poison Control
Center or doctor, or going for treatment.

Note to Physicians and Veterinarians: This product contains an
organophosphate and may cause cholinesterase inhibition. Cholinergic
symptoms may include salivation, miosis, incoordination, muscle fasciculation
and/or weakness, vomiting, and diarrhea. Atropine is antidotal. 2-PAM may
be effective as an adjunct to atropine. Call 1-800-275-1414 or your local
Poison Control Center for further information.

To kill fleas, ticks and lice, and to reduce itching and scratching due to insect
bites, dust entire cat beginning at head and working back. Make sure that the
powder gets down to the skin. Take care to treat feet and legs. Recommended
Dosage: Use approximately 1/3 ounce of powder for a small cat. Use
approximately 1/2 ounce of powder for a large cat. There is sufficient powder
in this container to treat a large cat about 8 times.
