Recommended Dosage: Use approximately ½ ounce of powder for a small dog (e.g. Terrier). Use approximately 1 ounce of powder for a medium dog (e.g. Spaniel). Use approximately 1 ¼ ounce of powder for a large dog (e.g. Labrador). More powder may be needed for longhaired dogs. There is sufficient powder in this container to treat a small dog 4 (8) times.

Lightly dust dog's bedding with approximately the same amount of powder. Repeat treatment of dog and bedding at weekly intervals if necessary.
