PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid inhalation of vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash contaminated skin promptly with soap and warm water. For eyes, flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. DO NOT use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Close doors and windows and turn off fans and air conditioners. Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using this product in these areas, apply only when facility is not in operation. Open cabinets and doors to expose spaces to be treated. Extinguish all flames, except pilot lights and release can at least 6 feet away from pilot lights. For best results leave treated space undisturbed for two hours or more. After treatment open doors and windows and allow to ventilate for 30 minutes.

AS A TOTAL RELEASE SPRAY

DIRECTIONS: Holding container upright and away from you tilt spray nozzle until tip engages rim of valve mounting cup. Valve will remain in open position for total release of contents. Place in upright position in an elevated location (if possible) such as on stand or table. Place paper under can to protect surface immediately around area of release. Release the contents of this can for each 5,000 cubic feet of unobstructed space. Use additional units for remote areas or where free flow of fog is not assured. Do not remain in room during treatment. Do not use as total release aerosol after using manually.

AS A SPRAY INSECTICIDE

To kill flies, mosquitoes, gnats, wasps, flying moths: Direct spray upward into center of room with slow sweeping motion. Spray 5 to 10 seconds for average room. Keep nozzle three feet from surfaces. Keep room closed for 15 minutes.

To kill roaches, waterbugs, silverfish, crickets, ants: Spray baseboards, cracks, crevices, moist areas, and openings around sinks and pipes and other hiding places. Kill insects directly. Spray ant hills and ant trails around window frames and door sills and other locations. Repeat as necessary for control.

To kill fleas: Spray floor coverings and sleeping quarters of pets. Repeat as necessary.
