The submitted Confidential Statement of Formulas (CSFs) are not acceptable for the reasons listed below:

1. There is no information available at EPA for Belmay Chemical Inc.'s Phase B30 deodorant fragrance. Therefore, you should request the supplier to provide EPA with the complete chemical composition, Material Safety Data Sheet and Health Effects for Phase B30. If it is a mixture, the supplier should provide for each component in the mixture, the chemical name, CAS Registry Number and percentage or range in percentage in the mixture.
2. Based on the alternate formulations dated 8/22/89, your products will not meet the label claim for the active ingredient. Please revise the CSF so the information agrees. Note that the lower limit of the active ingredient must be the same as the label claim in pure active form.
