GENERAL CLASSIFICATION: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DO NOT UNROLL COLLAR UNTIL READY TO USE.
TO ACTIVATE INSECTICIDE GENERATOR.

Do not unroll collar until ready to use. Place the Hartz "2 in 1 PLUS"™ collar around the dog's neck, adjust for proper fit, and buckle in place. The collar must be worn loosely to allow for growth of the dog and to permit the collar to move about the neck. Generally, a properly fitted collar is one that when fastened will snugly slide over the dog's head. Leave 2 or 3 inches on the collar for extra adjustment and cut off and dispose of the extra length. Some animals may become irritated by any collar if it is applied too tightly. If this occurs loosen the collar. If irritation continues, remove the collar from the animal. This collar is intended for use only as an insecticide generator.

Kills fleas and ticks common to dogs, including Rocky Mountain Wood Tick, carrier of Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever. The collar will begin to kill fleas and ticks immediately. Its full protection against harder to kill ticks will be built up within a few days after being placed on the pet. For continuous flea protection under normal conditions, replace the collar every seven months. The collar kills ticks for 5 months and aids in their control an additional 2 months. Under conditions where dogs are exposed to severe flea and tick infestations it may be necessary to replace the collar more frequently or augment its activity with another product registered for this use, such as Hartz 2 in 1 Flea and Tick Powder or Spray. Wetting will not impair the collar's effectiveness or the pet's protection. If the dog goes swimming or is out in the rain it is not necessary to remove the collar. The Hartz "2 in 1 Plus"™ collar may be worn with a regular collar. It is recommended that the pet's bedding or sleeping quarters be treated for flea and tick control with a product registered for this use such as Hartz 2 in 1 Flea & Tick Spray.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL - Do not reuse empty pouch. Wrap and dispose of used collars, excess collar and pouch in the trash.
