The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

Delete "petroleum distillate" from the active ingredient declaration on your label, and incorporate its percentage as part of the inert ingredient percentage declaration. Add the phrase "Contains petroleum distillate" as a substatement to the ingredient statement.

As new labels are prepared, add the general heading "Precautionary Statements" to introduce the Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals paragraph. Refer to 40 CFR, part 156.10(h)(2) for further guidance.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. For control of fleas, lice and ticks, including the Deer Tick, which may carry Lyme Disease, on dogs and cats, dilute 4 ounces of Hartz 2 in 1[®] Flea & Tick Dip with 1 gallon of water. Dip animal into solution, making sure hair is thoroughly wet to the skin. The area around the ears should be sponged thoroughly. Avoid contact of material with eyes and mouth of animal. Do not rinse. Towel dry. Repeat as necessary for control.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in a cool place, away from heat or open flame. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

CAUTION

Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin or eyes. Do not contaminate food or feedstuffs with this concentrate or dip. Toxic to fish. It is not advisable to use this or similar pesticides on animals less than 6 weeks old.

Physical Hazards: Do not use, pour, spill or store near heat or open flames. Do not contaminate any body of water with this concentrate or dip.
