- 1. Revise the statement "Contains Sodium Nitrite and Petroleum Distillate" to read as follows:

Contains Sodium Nitrite.

- 2. Revise the Storage and Disposal section of the product label to read as follows:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in an area inaccessible to children.
DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

- 3. Submit a current Confidential Statement of Formula to the Agency for the record.

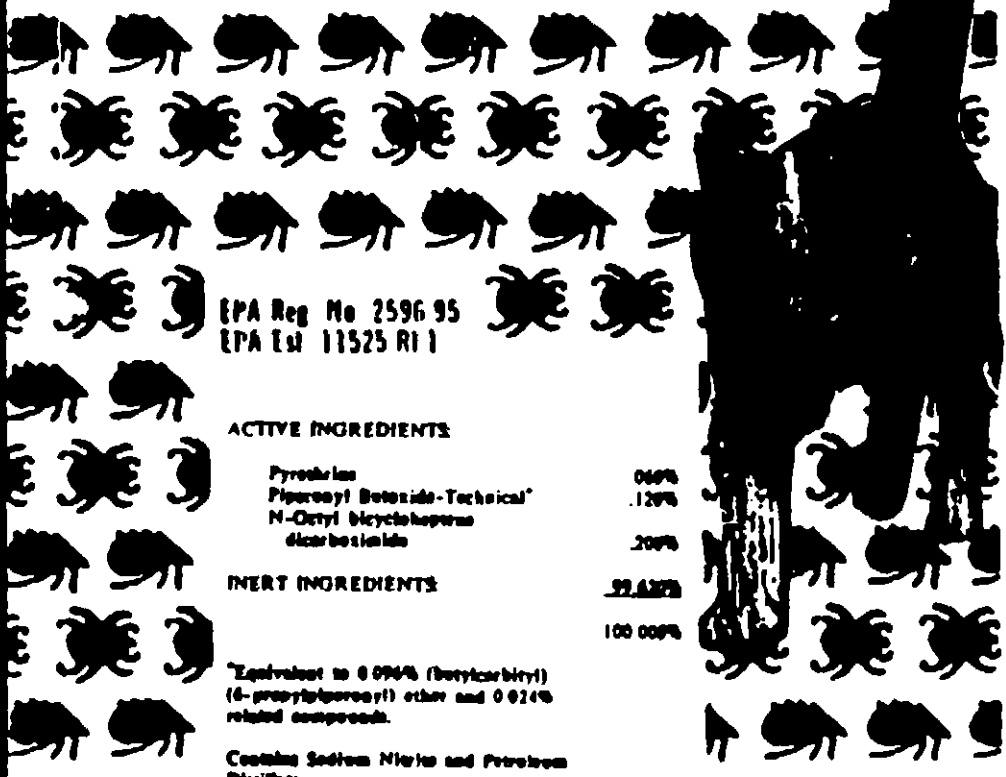

1. Shake well. Remove overcap.
2. Hold can upright about 1 foot from pet. Point nozzle toward pet. Do not hold tip of fingers. Move can to get even coverage. (Lips of hair are moist).
3. Apply lightly and rub into hair for spray to reach skin. 10 to 15 seconds to a five pound cat.
4. Dry with towel.
5. Comb and brush coat.
6. Repeat once a week if needed and surrounding area.
7. Kills fleas in 5 to 10 minutes. Wash thoroughly—spray directly.

Storage and Disposal

Do not re-use empty container and put in trash collection.
