1. Revise the statement "Contains Sodium Nitrite and Petroleum Distillate" to read as follows:

Contains Sodium Nitrite.

2. Revise the Storage and Disposal section of the product label to read as follows:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in an area inaccessible to children.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

3. Submit a current Confidential Statement of Formula to the Agency for the record.

4. After 10 minutes dry dog's coat.
5. Comb and brush coat.
6. Repeat once a week for flea control on bedding and surrounding areas.
7. Kills fleas in 5 to 10 minutes when sprayed directly.

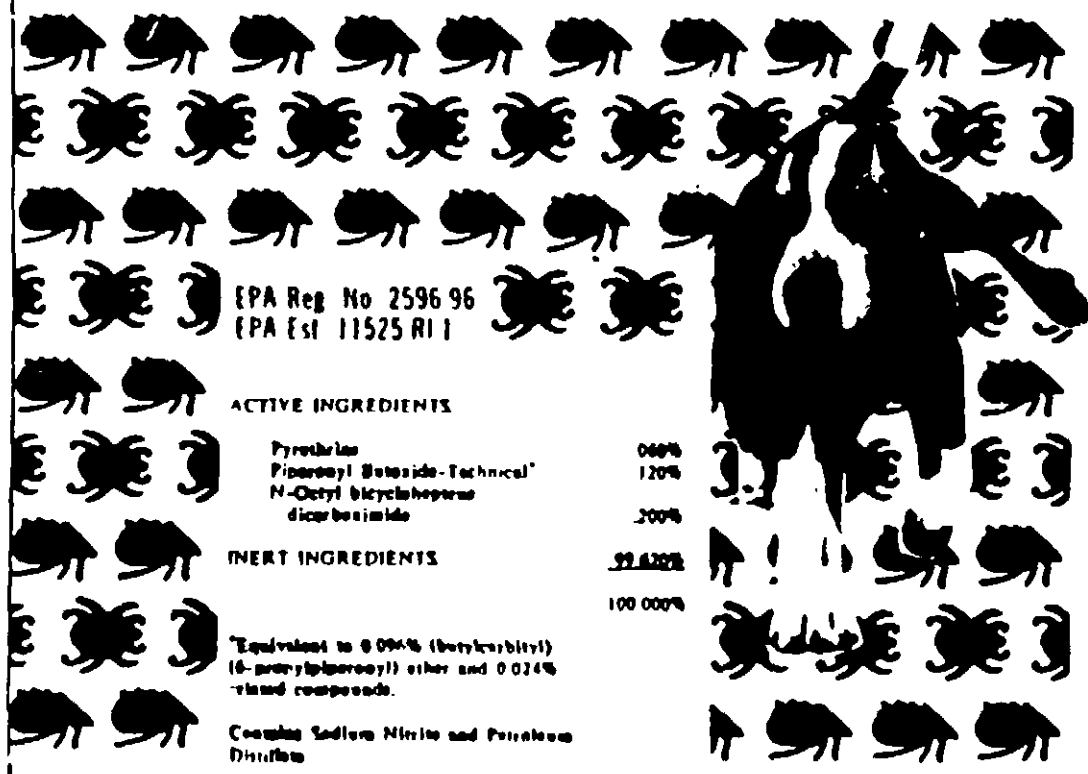
