1. Shake well. Remove overcap.
2. Hold can upright about 10 to 12 inches from pet. Point nozzle toward pet and press button. Do not hold tip of finger in front of nozzle. Move can to get even coverage of coat (until tips of hair are moist).
3. Apply lightly and rub into animal's coat. For long haired dogs, ruffle hair to reach skin.
4. After 10 minutes dry dog with towel.
5. Comb and brush coat.
6. Repeat once a week for fresh, glossy coat. Use on bedding and other areas as needed.
7. Ticks are tough—spray directly.

Disposal: Do not re-use empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

DIRECTIONS: Hold container upright, nozzle away from you and press actuator button spraying as directed. Kills and repels stable flies, horse flies, face flies, deer flies, house flies, horn flies, mosquitoes and gnats.

To Treat Animals: To protect cattle from attacks of stable flies, horn flies, deer flies, house flies, horn flies, mosquitoes and gnats spray about 3 seconds on each side being careful to spray back withers and forelegs thoroughly. To protect from face flies, spray the face and head, but do not spray into the eyes. Repeat treatment as necessary when flies are troublesome.

An Animal Quarters, Milk Rooms, and Food Plants: For rapid control of house flies, mosquitoes, gnats, wasps and small flying moths close windows and doors and spray at the rate of one second per 1000 cubic feet of space. For best results keep area closed for 10 minutes after spraying. Do not remain in treated area and ventilate after treatment is completed.

This Industrial Aerosol Insecticide contains a concentrated synergized pyrethrum formulation and is specially designed for use in Food Processing Plants, Canning Factories, Restaurants, Cafeterias, Bakeries, Dairies, Stores and Markets.
