


General classification: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

1. Shake well. Remove overcap.
2. Hold can upright about 10 to 12 inches from pet. Point nozzle toward pet and press button. Do not hold tip of finger in front of nozzle. Move can to get even coverage of coat (until tips of hair are moist).
3. Apply lightly and rub into animal's coat. Ruffle hair for spray to reach skin. Spray 4 to 6 seconds for a five pound cat, vary according to weight of cat.
4. Dry with towel.
5. Comb and brush coat.
6. Repeat once a week if necessary. Use on bedding and surrounding areas as needed.
7. Ticks are tough--spray directly.

Storage and Disposal

Do not re-use empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
