DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To kill fleas, ticks, and lice, thereby reducing incidence of itching and scratching, hold container 6 to 10 inches from the animal and spray lightly over the entire body. Do not spray in eyes. For best penetration of spray to the skin, direct spray against the natural lay of the hair to cause fluffing of the coat.

Under normal circumstances, repeat spray once every few days until infestation is brought under control, then repeat as necessary. For more prolonged flea and tick control, the animal's bedding, quarters, and surrounding area should also be sprayed lightly until damp to help prevent reinfestation.

Storage and disposal: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal. Wrap empty container and put in trash collection.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION Harmful if swallowed. Avoid inhalation of spray. Avoid spraying in eyes. It is good practice to wash hands after use. Do not contaminate water or food.
